Cascade Clamps - Cascade Manufacturing Company was established in Portland, Oregon in 1943. They began as a small machine shop at first employing 4 people. Sales for their initial year of operation amounted to about \$60,000. The first recorded sales revenues involved the machining and assembly of stainless-steel valves, pipe fittings and different components. Within 5 years of operation, the business had stretched to forty staff and their yearly sales volume had risen to 330 thousand dollars. These days, Cascade is amongst the top international producers within the material handling industry.

Manufacture and design of the company's initial hydraulic cylinder paved the way in Cascade's aggressive quest of new business possibilities. Over the last sixty years, the material handling business has developed into a very advanced area and Cascade has proudly performed a part on this progress. Cascade presently continues to develop as the best supplier of forklift attachments and different associated items. The company feels assured in their ability in order to continue to lead the way in the business by understanding customer's requirements in the future and remaining competitive within the world market.

In the nineteen fifties, Cascade started designing, making and selling hydraulic accessories. Manufacturing was done in the year 1956 on a brand new office so as to accommodate all the office and plant operations in Portland, Oregon at the company's present headquarters. Following 15 years of business, total staff reached one hundred eighty staff and sales had reached nearly two million three hundred thousand dollars.

In the year 1959 in Springfield, Ohio the next manufacturing plant was built. nineteen sixty marked Cascade's preliminary move into the international world of the material handling industry as the company recognized interest in England, Australia, and the Netherlands.

The company altered its name to Cascade Corporation in the year 1964. In the year 1965, Cascade went public with a preliminary offering of two hundred thousand shares of common stock. The company has expanded its manufacturing plants throughout the U.S. with locations in Warner Robins, Georgia, Portland, Oregon and Springfield, Ohio. Cascade merchandise are made internationally due to a lot of subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a brand new facility was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European headquarters. This facility is made to be the essential customer support centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in the year 1996 and the year 1997 after buying five companies, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the worldwide best in forks.
